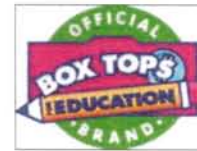

## **Audition Notice to all students of St. Francis de Sales School in grades 5K-8**

This year's musical production will be Disney's *Beauty and the Beast, Jr.*, as was announced at the Home and School December meeting. Auditions will take place on Monday, January 9 and Wednesday, January 11 from 3:30-4:30 p.m. in the parish center. Once again, JaNelle Powers has volunteered to direct our children's musical production. Due to her schedule, auditions will take place next week followed by a meeting for parents of the cast on Monday, January 16 @ 6:30 pm in the school gym.

Rehearsals for songs and lines will begin after basketball season (beginning of March) with help from parents, alumni, Mrs. Hayes, Mr. Buchberger and Mrs. Nateghi. There will be two days: Wednesday for principal parts and Thursday for all cast members. JaNelle will run rehearsals in April for choreography and blocking. There will be three days: Monday for principal parts and Wednesday & Thursday for all cast members. A detailed schedule will follow for parents to know when students are to be at rehearsal. A bus will transport the cast from St. Francis to Burlington after school the week of rehearsals before performances (May 7-10). The cast will also have a bus provided to take them to Catholic Central an hour before the school performance on Friday, May 11.

There will be three performances at Topper Hall. A school performance will be on Friday, May 11 in the morning. There will be two performances open to the public: one on Friday, May 11 at night and another on Saturday, May 12 in the afternoon.

If your child is in grades 6-8 and is not interested in being onstage, please let them know that other opportunities exist for them to be an important part of the show. Other positions include but are not limited to stage crew, wardrobe, props, sets, lights and sound. Please let me know what job they wish to do so we can connect them to the appropriate parent in charge of that aspect of the musical.

I hope this covers your initial questions. Again, we are sorry for the last minute notice but once the musical is cast, rehearsals will not be until March 1<sup>st</sup> for all cast members.

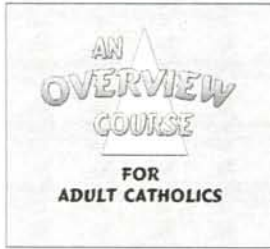
